In our **Easter** season and even more in the **Pentecost** season we will be thinking a lot about *discipleship*. Discipleship is sort of a strange word, isn't it? While you might think it is the condition of *BEING a student of or following Jesus*, since disciple means "learner" or "student," DISCIPLESHIP'S connotation is somewhat broader. Jesus, himself, told us in his **Great Commission** that following him (i.e. discipleship) included going out and **MAKING** disciples of the world! (Mt. 28:19). All in all, discipleship is about our living God's way in this world AND sharing that way with others.

It is not always easy to remember to do both parts of this definition, especially the "*sharing with others*" part. In a silly moment once, as I was contemplating the word, it occurred to me that this is because discipleship has nothing to do actually with being on a ship! Ha! **There is no disciple-ship!** In fact, what we need to avoid is operating as if we were unto ourselves, as if we were on a ship... isolated... at sea! We need to remember that we, the Church, as Dietrich Bonhoeffer said in his book *Letters and Papers from Prison*, "are only the Church when we exist for others." He further said that the Church is the true Church when "it is serving and acting to change the status quo 'from below'."

Right! The Church is only the church when it exists for others. Now, one thing that I've learned since I've been at Grace Presbyterian, as your Interim Pastor and now your Session Moderator and consultant, is that this church in no way acts as if it is out to sea by itself. Grace Presbyterian knows it is called to be a gospel people, called to make disciples not only within its faith community but outside its walls. Through the GPC worship, ministries, programs, goals, budget... **all of it...** there is a quiet underlying reminder to reach out to share and care for others and in so doing, make disciples... disciples who will do the same. Even the sending song, sung each week, emphasizes it. "**By the grace of God in Christ Jesus, The Spirit is upon us, To magnify the name of the Lord, to make him disciples, to meet the needs of the least of these. So go in peace, go in joy, go in the Spirit of the Lord.**" (Allen) I believe with all my heart that you are doing a good job of this, and I pray that you keep the vision and energy to stay the course this season and forever. *It's discipleship.* And it has much to do

with how we together experience God's joy. When we realize that we are **blessed to be a blessing**, that our life together is not about us only, that the "*church is only the church when it exists for others,*" we will experience the joy that was known on that first Pentecost morning when the Spirit moved and the church was born so long ago.


